



DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

FOR A TEMPORARY RESIDENT VISA

The documents you need to attach to your application are detailed on this form. If any of the required documents are missing, your application will be returned to you.

All documents in a language other than English or French must be translated. Provide both a photocopy of the document and the translation in English or French.

I have enclosed the following items:

Put an "X" in the box when you have enclosed the item

- Completed "**Application for a Temporary Resident Visa**" (IMM 5257)
- Use of a Representative (IMM 5476), if applicable
- Fee payment in an acceptable format. Verify acceptable methods of payment with the Visa office responsible for your area.
Note: Visa offices cannot accept payment receipts from banks in Canada
- "**Statutory Declaration of Common-law Union**" (IMM 5409) (if applicable)

For yourself and each accompanying family member included on the application:

- **Valid passport** (there must be one completely blank page other than the last page, available in each passport)
- Two photos, meeting the requirements of Appendix B - Photo Specifications. *On the back of one photo (and only one) in each set, write the name and date of birth of the person appearing in the photo*
- *Photocopy* of your current immigration document (if applicable) (e.g. study permit, work permit or temporary resident permit)
- Proof of financial support, as specified in the "**Visiting Canada**" section of this guide
- **Photocopy** of your valid return ticket (if you have one)
- Any additional documents required by the responsible visa office
